<b>lung_cancer_status</b>	Lung Cancer Status	<p>Lung cancer status.</p> <p>Cancers are considered confirmed if a cancer registry reported the cancer or if the medical encounter data indicated a cancer which met the AFHSD definition of cancer incidence. Unconfirmed cancers are those reported in the medical encounter data that do not meet the definition of cancer incidence.</p> <p>Because the lungs are a common site for cancer metastasis, lung cancers that do not have registry confirmation and which are not the first cancer the subject has, but which would meet the medical encounter incidence definition, are placed in a separate level for non-first cancers.</p>	0="No Cancer" 1="Confirmed Cancer" 2="Unconfirmed Cancer" 3="Non-first Cancer"
